Workforce contraction during Obama's first term showed **5,272,917** American jobs lost, while his **22** million increase in UI claimants averaged **107,600** more jobs lost each week and **495,000** for months with 31 days than registered job losses under Bush.

Through **29** months of **MAGA** change, the **94,917,000** **Not in Labor Force** (NILF) count has dropped an impressive **857,000** from the final full month figure under Obama, at **95,774,000** entering **2017**. The **80,686,000** count inherited by Obama spiked **15.1** million, **60 %** of whom were considered working age Americans between **20** and **64** years of age.
